## OUR MISSION





## OUR HISTORY

It began with a special gift. Shortly before being traded to the Detroit Red Wings in June 2001, two-time Stanley Cup champion, & Olympic Gold Medalist Dominik "The Dominator" Hasek graciously donated the sum of \$1,000,000.00 to the Community Foundation for Greater Buffalo. This gift would help to underwrite a program that would teach underprivileged inner-city youth how to skate & play hockey. Better known as Hasek's Heroes, The Dominik Hasek Youth Hockey League Inc. was born.

During his nine years as star goalie for the Buffalo Sabres, Dominik saw our inner-city kids & was reminded of his own humble beginnings, as a boy growing up in Czechoslovakia. He knew how the high cost of hockey equipment made the sport prohibitive for many low to moderate income families, but if there was a way that he could make this equipment freely available, then hundreds of kids could have an opportunity to play.

Dominik soon enlisted the help of his friends in the NHL. At Dominik's urging, the National Hockey League Players' Association, donated \$30,000 worth of equipment to the program. Grants were issued from the United Way, the M&T Bank Foundation, the Cameron Baird Foundation, & the John R. Oishei Foundation. Hasek's Heroes then began to receive on-going support from Buffalo Sabres Alumni & NHL DIVERSITY. Now retired from the NHL, & living in his native Czechoslovakia with his family, Dominik continues to be involved in the growth & development of Hasek's Heroes, visiting the club & assisting in the procurement of charitable donations.

During its inception, Hasek's Heroes utilized two ice rinks, but its board of directors found the logistics of a dual-location youth program too expensive & difficult to manage. In December of 2005, the decision was made to take over the operation of Riverside Park's Bud Bakewell Ice Rink, from Erie County. This decision was a win for both the program & the county. Through the dedicated efforts & outstanding leadership of Executive Director Sean Green, Program Director Fred Korey, & others, Hasek's Heroes was able to streamline costs, while extending the rink's season by over two months.

The rink continues to offer regular services, while being home to the Bud Bakewell Hockey Association, the Explorer League, Canisius College's Division 1 Ice Hockey, & City Honors High School's hockey program, as well as such diversity programs as the Buffalo Sled Hockey Group & SABAH (Skating Association for the Blind & Handicapped).

## OUR PROGRAM

Hasek's Heroes is a 24 week, after-school-&-weekends-program that teaches basic skating & introductory hockey skills to any interested, eligible child in the city of Buffalo. Children ages 4 to 17 may participate & there is no charge for the program or the use of equipment.

Our expert coaching staff provides a safe & supportive environment where players participate in "small game hockey," which emphasizes teamwork & skill building, over competitive play. Our players build self-confidence & learn to respect themselves & others as they acquire new skills & improve their balance, agility, & coordination. The skills learned at Hasek's Heroes form a strong foundation from which young players, who possess the desire & aptitude, can go on to play competitive hockey at the high school level & beyond.

## Our program has four skill levels in which players may participate:

- Introductory Skating: Preliminary instruction in basic skating skills required for general recreation & introductory hockey.
- Introductory Hockey: Instruction in basic hockey technique, including: full
  equipment skating, stick handling, team play, & scrimmaging.
- Hockey Development: Instruction in basic hockey strategy, including: learning player positions, on-ice positioning, team play, & competitive team play.
- Competition: Instruction in advanced hockey strategy, including: developing
  given player position skills, team play, and competitive game play. At this level,
  players engage in inter-squad scrimmaging & have the opportunity to travel
  to Detroit, to participate in the Detroit Hockey
  Hockey in the Hood tournament.

### **Education Comes First**

Hasek's Heroes has partnered with Buffalo Public & Charter Schools to ensure that each child enrolled in our program succeeds in school. Our coaches & leaders meet regularly with teachers & school administrators to review the academic progress of each player & to set specific goals for achievement. The enrollment of each child in our program is contingent upon his or her adherence to these goals. Any child, who is not working towards his or her full academic potential, may not participate in our program.
